







Once you have attempted to reach the patient, you may need to change their Patient Status.

- Look up the patient.
- Click Edit next to Person Information.
- Look at the Medical Home section.
- If your clinic is listed as the Medical Home, you will have the full list for Patient Provider Status.
- Choose the Status that applies to your patient (see the hand out/previous slide)
- Remember, if the patient no longer resides in MI, check that box under MCIR Options.

MenB Assessment RELEASED!

- ► MenB is in MCIR Production as of January 24th! Here is some information on the features:
- ▶ 1) MenB is listed as a general routine vaccine series for 16 through 23 years with due date of 16th birthday (after MMWR October 23, 2015 date)
- ▶ 2) If no history of MenB vaccine, will be displayed as "MenB Category B" on the status screens, with verbage "Discuss/Due Now" (instead of eligible, due)
- ▶ 3) After dose 1 is given, MCIR will forecast dose 2 based on what MenB brand product was given
- ▶ 4) If both product brands have been given as dose 1 and dose 2, it will forecast final dose based on the last dose given product

MenB Assessment RELEASED!

- ▶ 5) MCIR will display doses given at 10 years and older under Other Administrations -there is no second dose forecasting for this age group at this time (MCIR will not forecast for patients with high risk indications)
- 6) Does not impact overall status
- ▶ 7) A '?' link (hover over '?' to see link) was added for DCH MenB quicklooks pdf document on Gen Info and Status displays for MenB
- ► The January Release did not have the ability to do a 2nd dose Recall. Planned for a later release. Announcement when available.
